

DANGEROUS GOODS & SAFETY

The information on this pamphlet has been provided to assist you in deciding what items you can safely carry, or expect a removalist to carry. Further reference to the Customs FIDI guide provided by your Consultant is also recommended.



















Some items can be moved but they have to be properly prepared before they are loaded onto a vehicle. It can be very disappointing to have a removalist arrive at your property only to discover they won't remove all your items. This will be because there are certain items they may not carry by law.

SOME INELIGIBLE ITEMS INCLUDE: GAS CYLINDERS

NOTE: Gas Cylinders must be carried in accordance with company policy and the appropriate dangerous goods code and legislation. At a minimum gas cylinders need to be purged and a certificate produced upon collection.

LAWN MOWERS OR OTHER GARDENING EQUIPMENT THAT CONTAIN FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS

NOTE: Lawn mowers and other gardening equipment should have the petrol drained from the tanks. If you are sending these interstate or into storage they will also need to be steam cleaned.

INELIGIBLE ITEMS FOR REMOVAL

Particular items that are or may be ineligible for removal in a van. These items may be classifed under the following categories

- Prohibited and dangerous goods
- Plants and Animals (see below)
- Weapons (see below)
- Items in unclean condition

ANIMALS and PLANTS

As a general rule, animals and plants such as domestic fowls, livestock, pot plants and shrubs cannot be accepted for transport in an international removal vehicle.

- Animals are moved by pet transporters by arrangement and in accordance with quarantine laws
- Plants can be transported, within Australia, under the relevant Dept of Agriculture certificate.

PROHIBITED DANGEROUS GOODS

Some commodities cannot be accepted for transport by air, sea or road under general conditions.

The following, in their classes are a few examples.

CLASS 1: Explosives eg. Ammunition, Flares, Fireworks

CLASS 2: Flammable Gases *eg. Oxygen, LPG, Methane*

CLASS 3: Flammable Liquids eg. Petrol, Paints, Methylated Spirits

CLASS 4: Flammable Solids *eg. Matches, Magnesium, Firelighters*

CLASS 5: Oxidising substances eg. Calcium Hypochlorite, Sodium Nitrate

CLASS 6: Toxic & Infectious substances *eg. Arsenic, Weed killers*

CLASS 7: Radioactive substances *eg. Wet batteries*

CLASS 8: Corrosive substances *eg. Oxides, Hydrochloric Acid*

CLASS 9: Miscellaneous eg. Scuba tanks, Gas Cylinders, Aerosol cans
